DECISION AND REASONS

1. This is an appeal brought with permission granted by the Upper Tribunal by the appellant, Mr Murtaza, against the decision of the First-tier Tribunal to dismiss his appeal by reference to the Immigration Rules and also by reference to Article 8 of the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms.
